#### Reduced anxiety and increased motivation

Live lessons can also have a positive effect on motivation levels as employees generally feel less competitive in a group setting and more likely to encourage each other. With accountability improved in group lessons, independent learning is also more likely to increase, making these lessons extremely beneficial and a more collaborative process.
